

HPV Vaccine Resources

<u>WHO NEEDS IT</u>: In addition to all youth beginning age 9, <u>the FDA recommends the HPV vaccine for all men</u> who have sex with men through age 45. There is no specific recommendation for transgender and nonbinary individuals but the vaccine is rated as <u>very safe</u> and <u>extremely effective</u> for everyone. If you didn't get the vaccine as a youth, it is strongly recommended that you do as an adult for the prevention of certain cancers and genital warts.

WHERE TO GET IT:

- If you have a **regular medical provider**, start there.
- If you **don't** have a regular medical provider, many **pharmacies** offer the vaccine and will take your insurance. Use the <u>HPV Vaccine Finder</u> to find the pharmacy nearest you that has HPV-9 vaccine.
- If your high school, college or university has a health center, most will have the HPV-9 vaccine.
- Many **public health clinics** and **community clinics** offer HPV-9 vaccine. Most take insurance. Uninsured? Many <u>free vaccine</u> to those that qualify. See the list below.
- If you are **18 or younger**, any **VFC** (Vaccines for Children) clinics can offer <u>free vaccine</u> to you even if you are undocumented.

Clinics Offering HPV Vaccine:

If you don't have a regular healthcare provider or you are uninsured, these community and public health clinics might be your best source of HPV vaccine. Click on names for <u>websites</u> and addresses for <u>maps</u>.

***Unless noted, ALL of these clinics <u>accept insurance</u>, offer <u>free vaccine to 18 and younger</u> through VFC and have <u>free vaccine available for qualified uninsured</u>. **We recommend you call ahead.**
