



END AIDS WASHINGTON – PAYER OPTIONS

Medical Visits and Lab Costs:

- If insured with commercial insurance or Medicare, you will have to pay your deductible, co-pay or coinsurance costs set by your plan for medical visits and lab tests.
- If insured with Medicaid (Apple Health), you will not have any out of pocket costs for medical visits or lab expenses.
- If uninsured, you will have to pay full cost of medical visits and labs as set by your provider and lab company.

Pharmacy Costs:

All health insurance plans in Washington State cover Truvada® for PrEP including Medicare and Medicaid.

- **If insured with commercial insurance or Medicare**, you will have to pay your deductible or co-pay for your prescription. You may be able to get assistance with your pharmacy costs from one of the following programs:
 - Gilead Co-pay Program <u>www.gileadcopay.com</u> or call 877-505-6986 (Must have commercial insurance (not Medicare) and must be able to prove you reside in US but do not have to be a legal US resident)
 - Patient Access Network www.panapply.org or call 866-316-7263 (Must have commercial insurance or Medicare and must be able to prove you reside in US but do not have to be a legal US resident)
 - Washington State PrEP Drug Assistance Program www.doh.wa.gov/prepdap or call 360-236-3412 (Uninsured, commercial insurance, or Medicare and can be legal or undocumented US resident)
- If insured under Medicaid (Apple Health), you will not have out of pocket costs as Truvada® for PrEP is covered at 100%.
- If you don't have health insurance, or a plan that covers PrEP, you should sign up or switch during the open enrollment period. You may be able to get assistance with your pharmacy costs from one of the following programs:
