HPV Vaccine Resources

WHO NEEDS IT: In addition to all 11 and 12 year olds, **the CDC recommends HPV Vaccine for all men who have sex with men through age 26.** There is no specific recommendation for transgender and non-binary individuals but the vaccine is rated as **very safe** and **extremely effective for everyone.** If you didn't get the vaccine at age 11 or 12, it is strongly recommended for the prevention of certain cancers and genital warts.

WHERE TO GET IT:

- If you have a **regular medical provider**, start there.
- If you **don't** have a regular medical provider, many **pharmacies** offer the vaccine and will take your insurance. Use the [HPV Vaccine Finder](#) to find the pharmacy nearest you that has HPV-9 vaccine.
- If your **high school, college or university** has a health center, most will have the HPV-9 vaccine.
- Many **public health clinics** and **community clinics** offer HPV-9 vaccine. Most take insurance. Uninsured? Many [free vaccine](#) to those that qualify. See the list below.
- If you are **18 or younger**, any **VFC** (Vaccines for Children) clinics can offer [free vaccine](#) to you – even if you are undocumented.

Clinics Offering HPV Vaccine:
